Introduction

Shared Reality Exchange is a blockchain-based **crowdfunding platform** and utility token that **helps the public resolve controversies.**

We help the public verify claims by giving them access to **a conclusive source of truth.**

We find, vet, and pay large numbers of specialists to answer society's most important questions.

The general public can also get those answers delivered to them for free, via our browser extension. In addition, **our system links public figures to their past controversial claims.**

Our ultimate goal is to align society with the natural order of the universe by **dissolving the habits of imagined divisions.**

The Problem

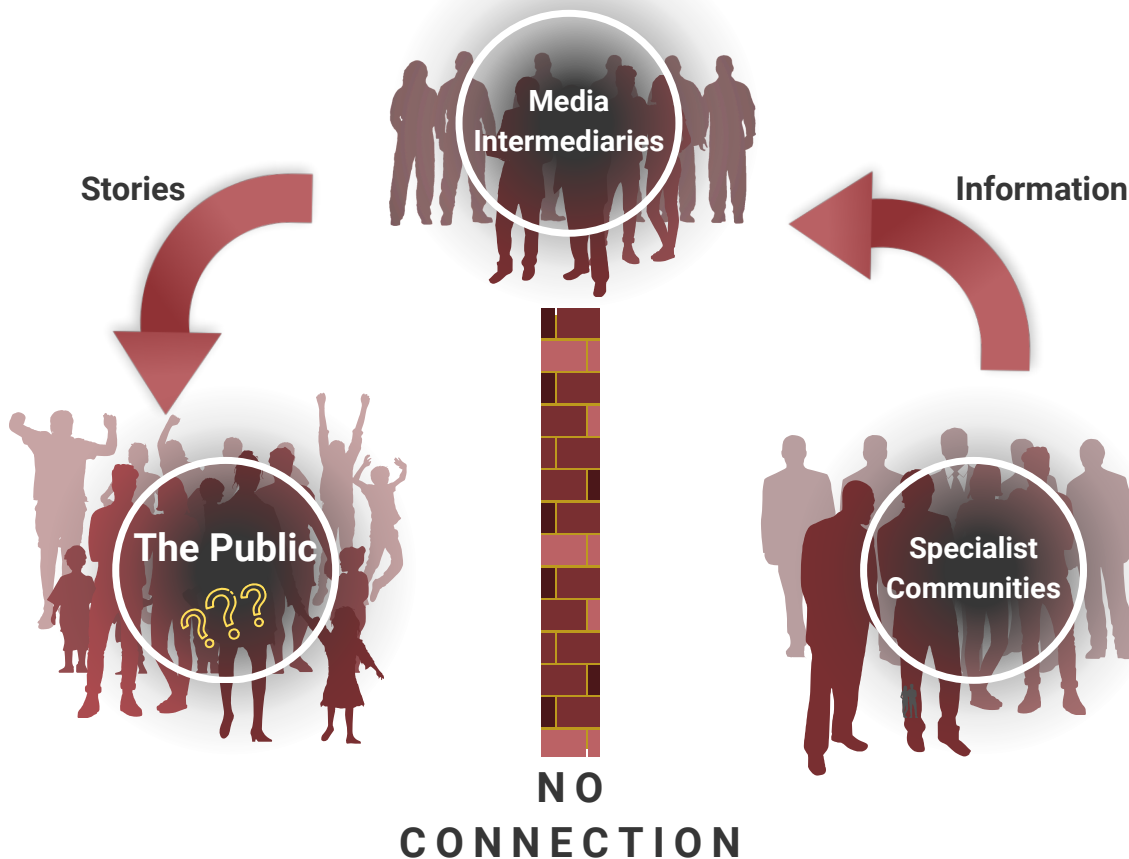
The public cannot verify assertions

Our public life is currently like a movie where groups have come to assign the roles of hero and villain in opposite ways.

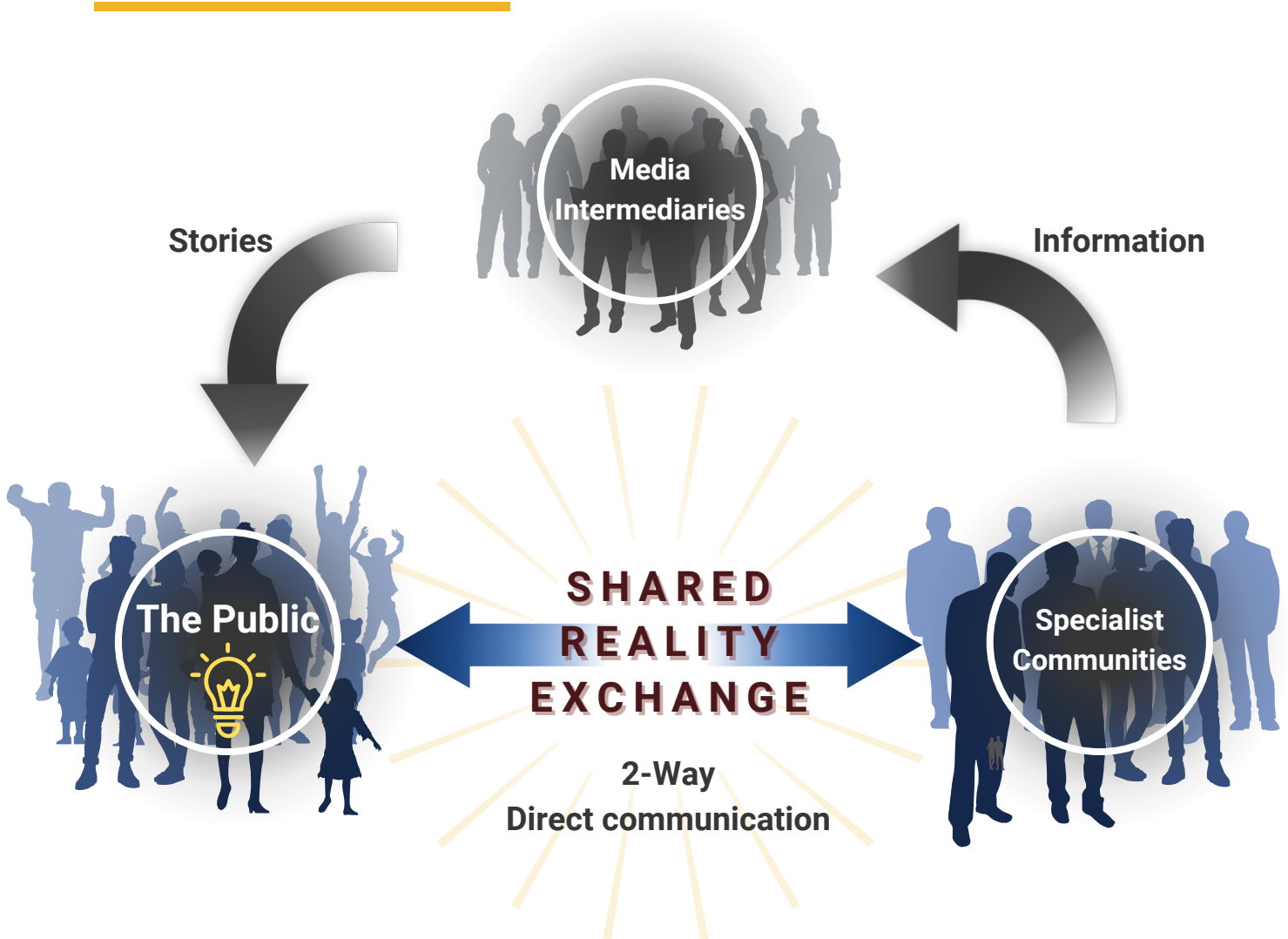
The public cannot come together in a single community because they are disconnected from a shared source of truth.

The public also cannot ask clarifying questions of specialists or public figures, which would help resolve controversies.

Critical conversations which would help build a shared reality around the actual truth simply never happen.



The Solution



The Shared Reality Exchange is a crowdfunding platform and browser extension that allows the public to a) verify assertions with large numbers of people who actually know, and b) ask specific questions of the people making questionable claims.

The resulting conversations are distilled into expert 5-star reviews of ideas and inserted directly into the web pages where disinformation is spread.

The Solution: Part I

The Crowdfunding platform



The public needs answers

With the Shared Reality Exchange, the public can raise funds to pay specific people, organizations, and specialist community members to respond to specific questions, and to share their reasoning and evidence.

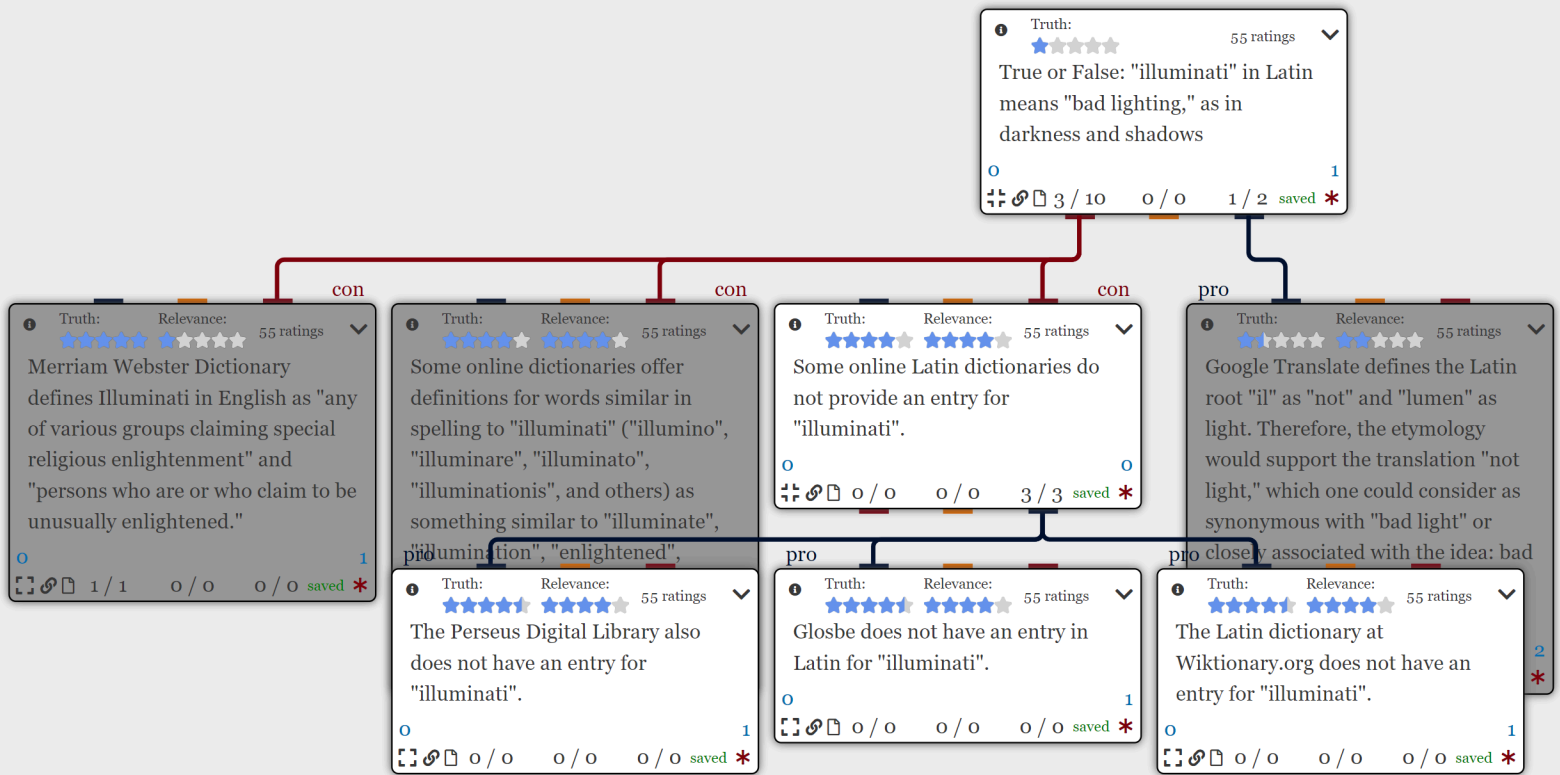
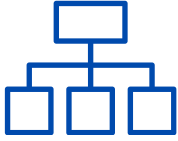
For example, the public can use the Shared Reality Exchange platform to:

- Find and vet all of the PhDs in atmospheric climate science to ask them **whether climate change is real and caused by human activity.**
- **Ask “Flat-earthers” for reproducible studies** which show that the sun is 3,000 miles from Earth.
- Ask Dr Christiane Northrup to share the evidence which had her assert, “this COVID-19 vaccine agenda is to target chromosomes eight, one, and two, which will remove human empathy.”

Whatever the answers to the above questions turn out to be, they will help us all get into the same shared reality. **The Shared Reality Exchange crowdfunding platform can get us those answers.**

The Solution: Part II

The Argument Map*



- We use the argument map document type to **create clarity between people** who do not already agree with each other on all points.
- It can include **all relevant information and source documents from both sides**, in one place.
- Conversations can be productive, comparing “apples to apples” across social boundaries.
- By using a structured, clear, and neutral document, **public figures can be asked to rebut or support specific ideas or evidence.**

The Browser Extension



Expert Five-Star Reviews of Ideas

Our browser extension inserts expert five-star reviews of ideas into web pages for free.

Assertions in web pages are highlighted:

On click, a list of their past false statements (according to specialists) is displayed.



If there are open campaigns asking for clarification about questionable assertions, these are also listed.

Advantages

Why Shared Reality Exchange?

Every other “fact-checker” asserts things. We don’t. **We allow the public to verify assertions** by providing a means of **direct and transparent communication** between the people who know things and the people who want to know those things.

Challenges can be brought in “real time.” Public figures can say something on the evening news and be **effectively challenged** before the program ends.



Our documents can include all ideas and evidence from **both sides**, effectively supporting the negotiation of the truth between friends and loved ones.

The mainstream perspectives of specialist communities are our best sources of truth, even when they are wrong. New ideas need to be vetted by qualified specialists, not the general public.

The Market



Disinformation is a global “mass-market” problem which affects us all.

The public is in acute pain on personal, interpersonal, communal, national and international levels.



People have no viable alternatives.

Many people are willing to pay for even the promise of a solution.



Why blockchain?

A Trustless Source of Truth



Removes Intermediaries

The core strength of blockchain is that it makes systems more efficient by removing intermediaries.

What Bitcoin did for currency, we will do for information and truth.



Unhackability Uncensorability

Blockchain is the only unhackable and uncensorable solution which is completely transparent in both code and data.



Complete Transparency

Everyone can see for themselves that the information added to the platform is the same as what is reported.

The Token

The Shared Reality Exchange cryptocurrency token will be an ERC20 token on an EVM-based L1 or L2 blockchain.

The token will be made available for purchase on Uniswap.

There will be at least two practical uses of the utility token on the platform:

- Those donating to campaigns using the SharedReality Exchange token will either pay no fee or a very small fee to the crowdfunding platform compared with those donating using other currencies.
 - When campaigns are complete and the remaining funds are released, donations made with our currency will be released back to the donor, free of charge. Donations made using a different currency will be held on the platform for use in other campaigns of the donor's choosing, or released to the donor for a fee.

The implications of the SharedReality Exchange platform are profound.

People base their behaviors around the public opinion of their communities. If that public opinion is based on untrue ideas, people will be challenged in cultivating the well-being they seek. This is one important reason why people are not generally at peace.

When public opinion is based on the truth, **virtuous cycles of communication** will support the effective cultivation of deep and authentic well-being for the general public.

We can all see clearly enough what it's like when the powerful bully the world with lies.

What will it be like when the powerful organize society based on the truth?

This is our chance to find out together.
